2. Requa Interceptor Project Report Number 15

Construction is now complete from the VSD plant to the intersection of Avenue 46 and Clinton Street, including the 10-inch main on Avenue 46 near Shields Road. Sewer main installation is also complete on Madison Street from just south of Mary Lane through the intersection of Madison Street and Highway 111. Sewage flows have now been intercepted at all interties along this same reach except for the portion on Madison Street. Construction work resumed on Avenue 46 at Clinton Street and is heading west towards Madison Street. Final paving on Aladdin Street, Avenue 46, and Madison Street occurred on August 1- 2, 2017. Striping work will follow in 2 to 3 weeks. The bore & jack tunneling under the All American Canal will begin by the end of August. DCI is heading towards the final stretch of construction work for this project. Change Order No. 13

contains PCO numbers 97 thru 107 for an amount of \$44,577.60. DCI, Inc. submitted a progress payment request for work completed to date.

DIRECTOR DAVENPORT made a motion to approve a progress payment to DCI, Inc. in the amount of \$893,322.42 and \$47,016.97 to be placed in a retention account, and to approve Change Order No.13 for \$44,577.60. DIRECTOR DURAN seconded the motion. Motion carried by the following roll call vote:
