3. General Manager's Report

Solar City is working with Imperial Irrigation District to complete the design on the interconnection and Mr. Glowitz has signed the final Power Purchase Agreement for final production. The District has an RFQ out for a new CCTV Van. All three cells at the wetlands have tested favorable for all constituents and the District is now working with the EPA to be able to abandon sludge in place. The Policy and Procedures Project is underway and a draft will be brought to the Board soon. The Requa project has reached Indio Boulevard heading toward Jackson Street. Mr. Glowitz thanked District staff for their hard work preparing the facility for the Solar Dedication Ceremony.
