4. Anti-Climb Fence Project Pay Application #2

This project is now complete. The anti-climb fence was installed along VSD's northeasterly property line adjacent to the White Water Storm Channel. There has been one (1) work addition during the course of this project. Additional concrete work was needed for a pad around the newly installed gate as well as the addition of a pad for the two (2) trash dumpsters. This concrete approach will provide for a permanent entrance and help protect the fence and gate footing due to occasional heavy traffic loads. The pad for the two (2) dumpsters provides for better aesthetics and ease of use for the trash trucks. Moore Fence Company, Inc. submitted a request for pay application number 2 for \$228,347.43 and Archuleta Concrete Company submitted a request for pay application number 1 for \$10,012.00.
