2. Discussion of the Insurance Renewal Proposal – Curtis & Harris Insurance Services

Hugh K. Curtis from Curtis & Harris Insurance Services presented the insurance renewal proposal for the 2018/2019 fiscal year. Curtis & Harris Insurance Services currently insures the District for property, general liability, management liability, inland marine, auto, umbrella and earthquake. The Board requested Mr. Curtis to explore the effect changing deductible amounts has on the premium. Staff will bring the information back to the board for further discussion.

3. Set Public Hearing to Adopt the Final Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Budget

4. Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Budget Study Session

MR. GLOWITZ presented the fiscal year 2018/2019 draft budget to the board. He pointed out the Operations and Maintenance budget has increased by 10.59% and the Capital Improvement Program has decreased by 6.3%. He also stated that there is a proposed 2.7% COLA increase for employees. The sewer use fee and connection capacity fee will remain the same. The Board gave Staff direction as to how to proceed. The final budget will be brought back to the board for approval on June 12, 2018.

5. General Manager's Report

MR. GLOWITZ distributed the most recent Innovative Federal Strategies update. He informed the Board that the District has once again received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for its Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for Fiscal Year Ending June, 30, 2017 from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) and Joanne Padgham was again presented the Award for Financial Reporting Achievement from the GFOA.
